FAMILY SERVICES OF GREATER VANCOUVER

Once every quarter, the Aura team gets together for a team-building activity, which often involves giving back through volunteering. Family Services of Greater Vancouver has warmly accepted donations from the Aura team, and this time we decided to support their COLTS program by providing food and other supplies to young parents finishing high school with babies, as well as providing food and supplies to unhoused youth. The Aura team was divided into 'mini teams,' each in charge of sourcing a specific need —whether it be soap, shampoo, diapers, food, etc. —to create care packages for these groups in need. Through this initiative, the Aura team was able to provide **10 young families** with the supplies they need and **50 unhoused youth** with food and other much-needed items.

In 2024, we collected **20 bins full of clothing** from Cadillac Fairview tenants and the surrounding community, proudly donating much-needed clothing and supplies to Covenant House.

During the event, Aura proudly sponsored a craft table, where **250 children** enthusiastically crafted handmade gifts for their family and friends to cherish during the holiday season. This festive occasion, orchestrated by Herman Miller and Contemporary Office Interiors, not only spreads joy but also offers underprivileged children the opportunity to create lasting memories and embrace the spirit of giving during the holiday season.

As a non-profit organization, TenantTalks is committed to giving back to the community while advancing thought leadership in office design and functionality. TenantTalks events feature expert speakers from various disciplines and global locations, offering attendees opportunities to share experiences, explore challenges, and engage with innovative concepts that are shaping modern work environments.

TenantTalks aligns closely with Aura's core values of community impact and collaboration. Each event designates a charity of choice, with 100% of ticket sale proceeds supporting organizations that drive meaningful social change.

In October 2024, Aura partnered with TenantTalks to host *Creating Spaces for Mental Health: The Role of the Workplace.* This event featured a keynote presentation and a panel discussion with Vancouver-based HR professionals from multiple industries. The program examined how workplaces can foster mental health and well-being, tackling issues such as the rise of loneliness in remote work settings and exploring strategies to enhance cognitive performance, emotional resilience, and physical health.

SUPPORTING WOMEN'S SUCCESS

This year's TenantTalks event successfully raised \$3,480 in support of Dress for Success Vancouver. a non-profit organization dedicated to empowering women through economic independence and career success. For over 25 years, Dress for Success has offered comprehensive programming, including professional attire services, pre-employment training, job retention initiatives, mentorship, leadership development, and career counselling. All ticket proceeds from the event contributed to this donation, which directly provided professional attire to **11 women** entering the workforce. This achievement exemplifies Aura's commitment to driving meaningful change in the workplace and the community, aligning with our purpose to Positively Impact People.
